Are Muslims Open to the Gospel?

- Islam is not the world's fastest growing religion.
 - Evangelical Christianity is.
- More Muslims have become followers of Jesus Christ in the last 25 years

than in the previous 1250 years.

 Many Muslims suffer under repressive regimes and lack human rights and educational and economic opportunities.

Where Do Muslims Live?

- Most Muslims are not Arabs and don't even live in the Middle East.
- Only 20% of Muslims today speak Arabic.
- Indonesia, Pakistan, India, and Bangladesh are the nations with the largest Muslim populations, each home to at least 100 million Muslims.
- About 2.6 million Muslims live in the U.S.
 Many are immigrants who grew up in
 Muslim families, but about one-third of them are American converts to Islam.

How Do Muslims See Jesus Christ?

- Most Muslims are not radicals. In fact, they are deeply offended by the actions of radicals in the name of Islam.
- Muslims respect Jesus as a prophet of God, born of a virgin, who performed many miracles and will come again.
- The Qur'an mentions Jesus 93 times, calling him the Messiah, the Word of God, the Spirit of God, and the All Righteous One.

What is Encountering the World of Islam?

Encountering the World of Islam is a twelve-lesson course which combines typical learning assignments with experiential activities and on-line interactions for an integrated learning environment. Each course lesson is taught by a different Muslim or Christian expert. In each lesson you will explore the Muslim world and God's plan for Muslims by reading from a collection of writings about the life of Muhammad, the history of Islamic civilization, Islamic beliefs, Muslims today, and the everyday lives of Muslims from Morocco to Indonesia. Gain insight into diverse Muslim cultures and worldviews as well as Christian outreach toward Muslims, our response to Islam, and prayer for the Muslim world. The course textbook has more than 80 authors providing a broad range of perspectives on Islam.
